We request participation of your group in the annual cultural event to promote, preserve, and propagate the Telugu cultural heritage in North America. Guidelines and rules:

- Each dance item may be classical, folk, Tollywood, or fusion and cannot exceed 30 minutes*
- Minimum 12 and maximum 25 students per group dance
 - Vocal performance must include instrumental accompaniment and cannot exceed 20 minutes*
- Must provide minimum 5 vocalists and 3 instrumental accompaniments per classical vocal performance
- No solo performances will be allowed
- Approximate stage size is 50 feet wide by 30 feet depth
- Free admission for the participants only on the day of the performance
- Attendees accompanying the participants MUST register
- No remuneration will be provided

*Including ascending, setup and descending the stage
